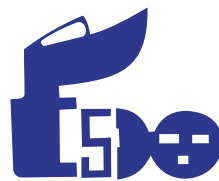

Executive Summary

The Supporting to Sudden Flood Survivors (SSF) in Northern Part of Bangladesh project was implemented by ESDO under alert # BO36. The project was started in 31 October 2021 and finished in 14th December 2021. The project covered Lalmonirhat and Nilphamari District of Bangladesh. The project covered WASH, Livelihood, Food/MPCG, NFI, GBV, DRR, Agricultural. The project provided Cash, hygiene kit and agricultural input support to 1925 household. Among 1925 project participants 94% were female, 18% were person with physically challenged. As a part of DRR activities the project has distributed message on flood preparedness and snakebite through handbill,

renovated 1.1 km muddy road, conducted road side tree plantation in 1.1 km road, generated 218 persons CFW for 1756 person days. There were 86% female project participants were work in the CFW. There were 33% minority groups (Hindu beneficiaries) and 2% person with physically challenged person work in the CFW. As a part of the actions against GBV the project has reconstructed 180 meter wood/ metal/cement bridge and installed 11 solar lamp in hotspot. As a part of COVID 19 the project has distributed 50 piece mask to each 1925 HH, distributed handbill and oriented the project participants. As a part of dignity kit the project has distributed reusable sanitary cloths of the project participants.

Executive Director Speech



It is my immense pleasure to write about the 2021- B036 Response in north with the support of Start Fund Bangladesh. Unfortunately the northwestern districts of Bangladesh regularly badly experience devastating flash floods almost every year. Climate change has become an emerging problem in Bangladesh that is largely affecting agricultural productivity, food security, and human mobility. The frequency and severity of various hazards increased over the last few decades because of the changes in climate. The main reason for flash flooding in north-western Bangladesh is not only the heavy rainfall within the country, but also other issues, including snowmelt from the upstream countries, deforestation, shrinking of the rivers' capacity, building of dams in the upstream for irrigation and many more. One of the World Bank's studies shows that among various types of hazards, the damage caused by flood is 23 percent while it is 19% by cyclone and 15% by landslide. Any disaster always makes much more vulnerability for the extreme poor including women, children, elderly people and disable persons. In general, some coping strategies done by comparatively better people but in the case of said communities continued through an inhuman experience. This year, the situation was much more critical due to this disaster that came within the pandemic situation. Nobody responded in the remote and backward places-where necessity was highest. A lot of thanks to Start Fund Bangladesh for the rapid response about our proposal. It is one of the best examples that, within seven days of the disaster, we were able to respond to flood victims. I would like to convey our heartiest gratitude to Start Fund Bangladesh, UKAID & Netherland Embassy for their most appropriate support. Specially I conveyed our wholehearted salute to the Start Fund Bangladesh Team for their excellent technical support. The Upazilla Parishad, Union Parishads, Concern Government officials were also actively involved with different steps of the response. A big thanks to them. Finally, I also conveyed my salute to our response team- their dedication is the key pillar for great success. We are expecting for poverty free Bangladesh through the people's centered initiative.

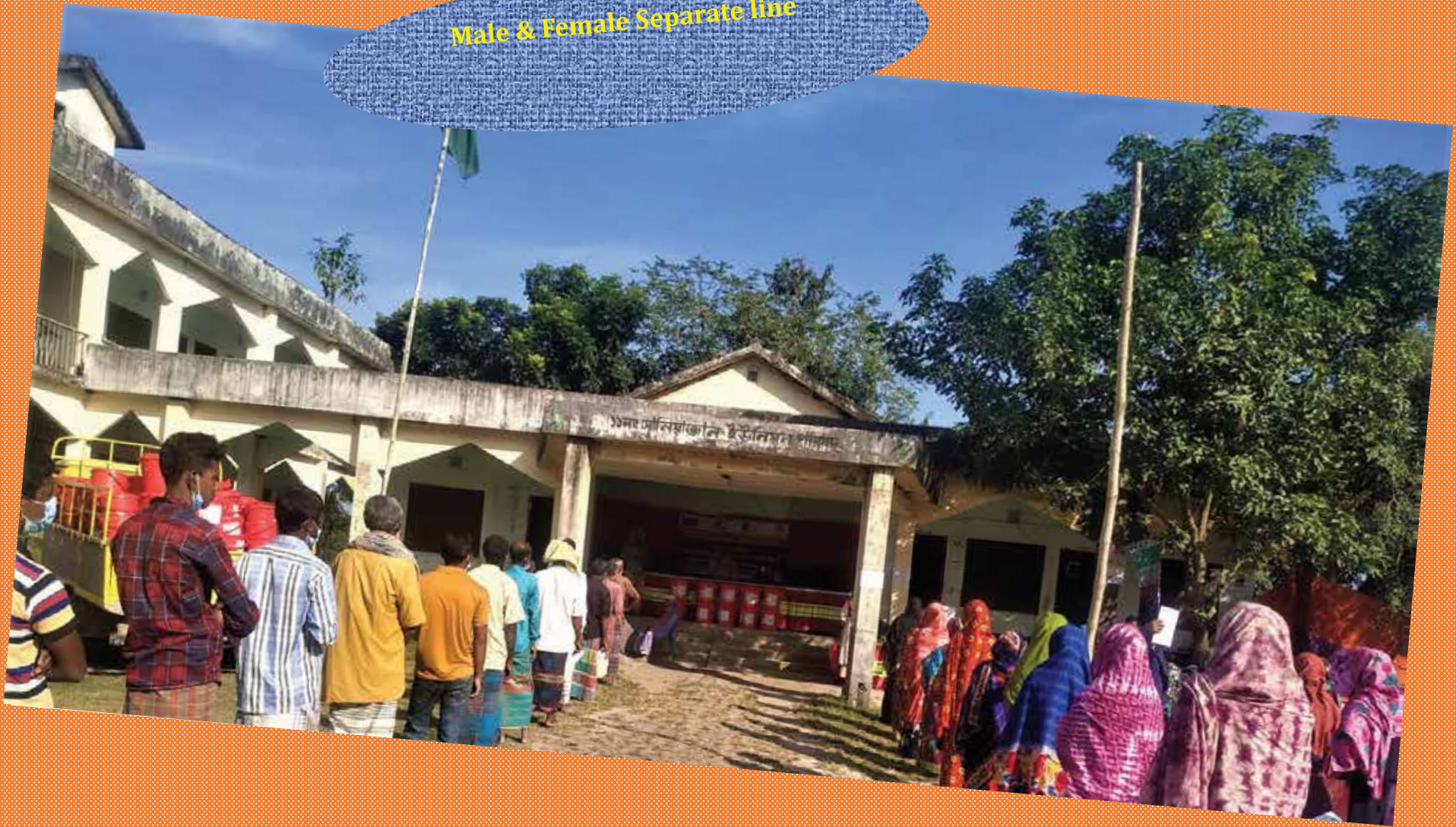

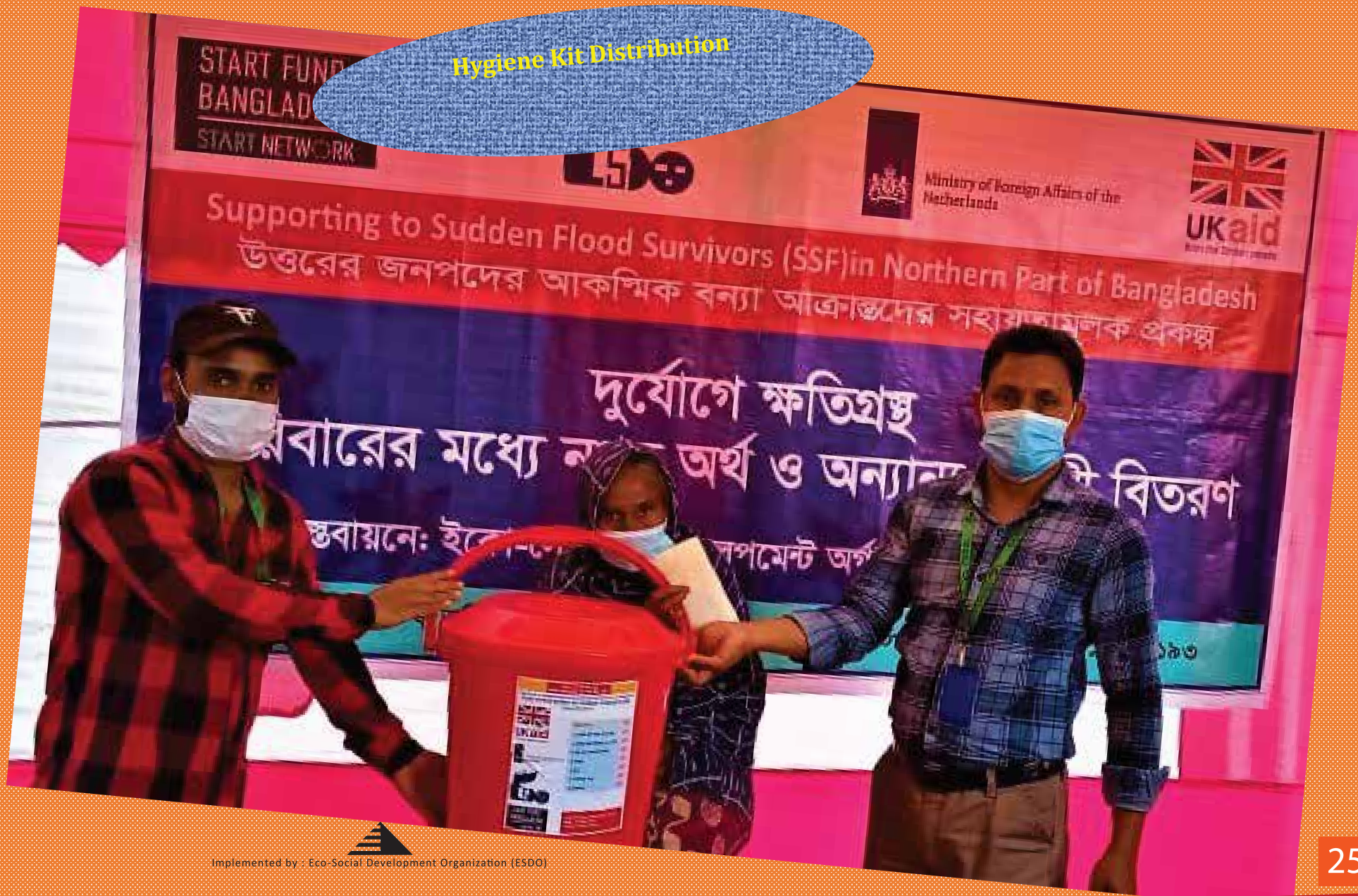

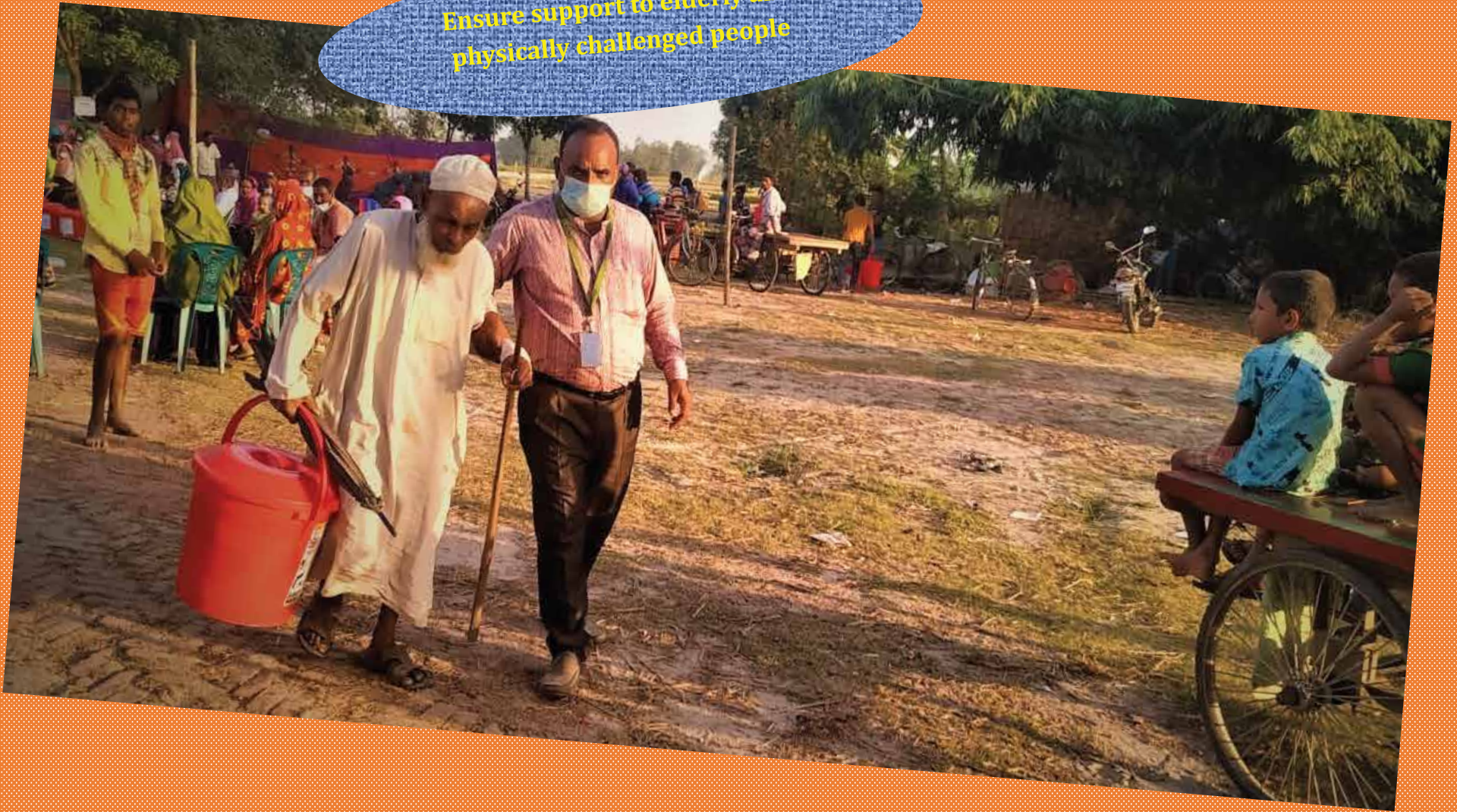

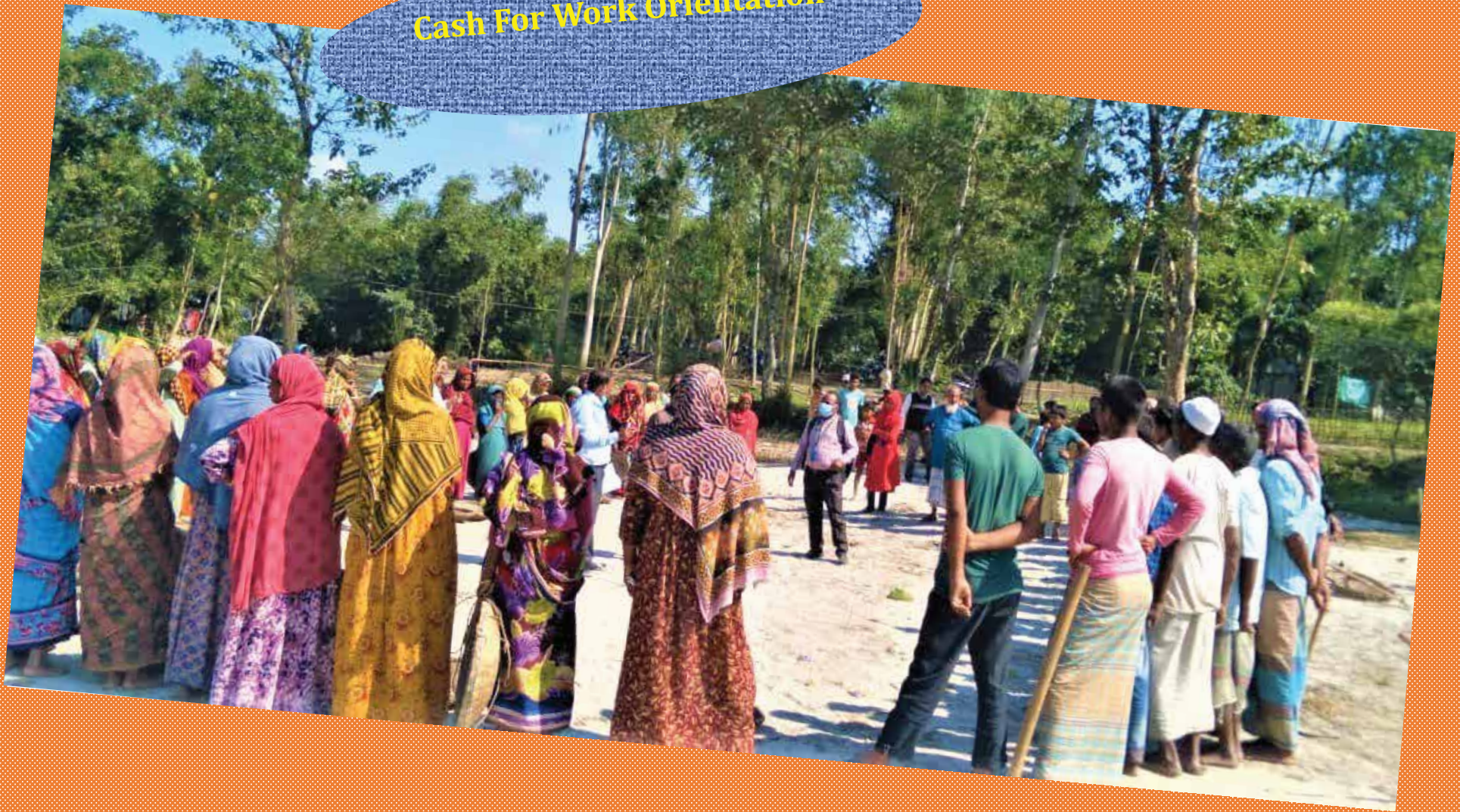

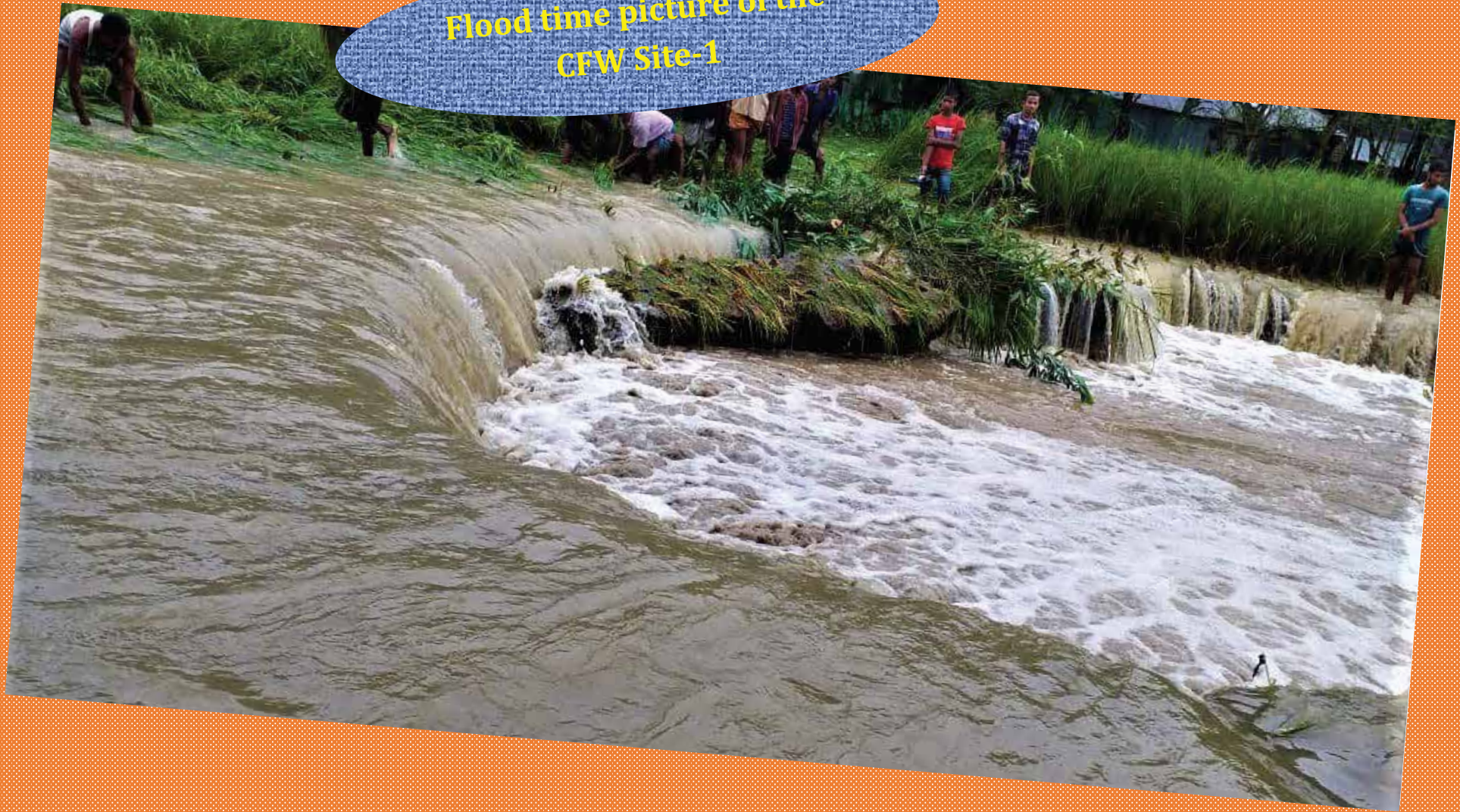

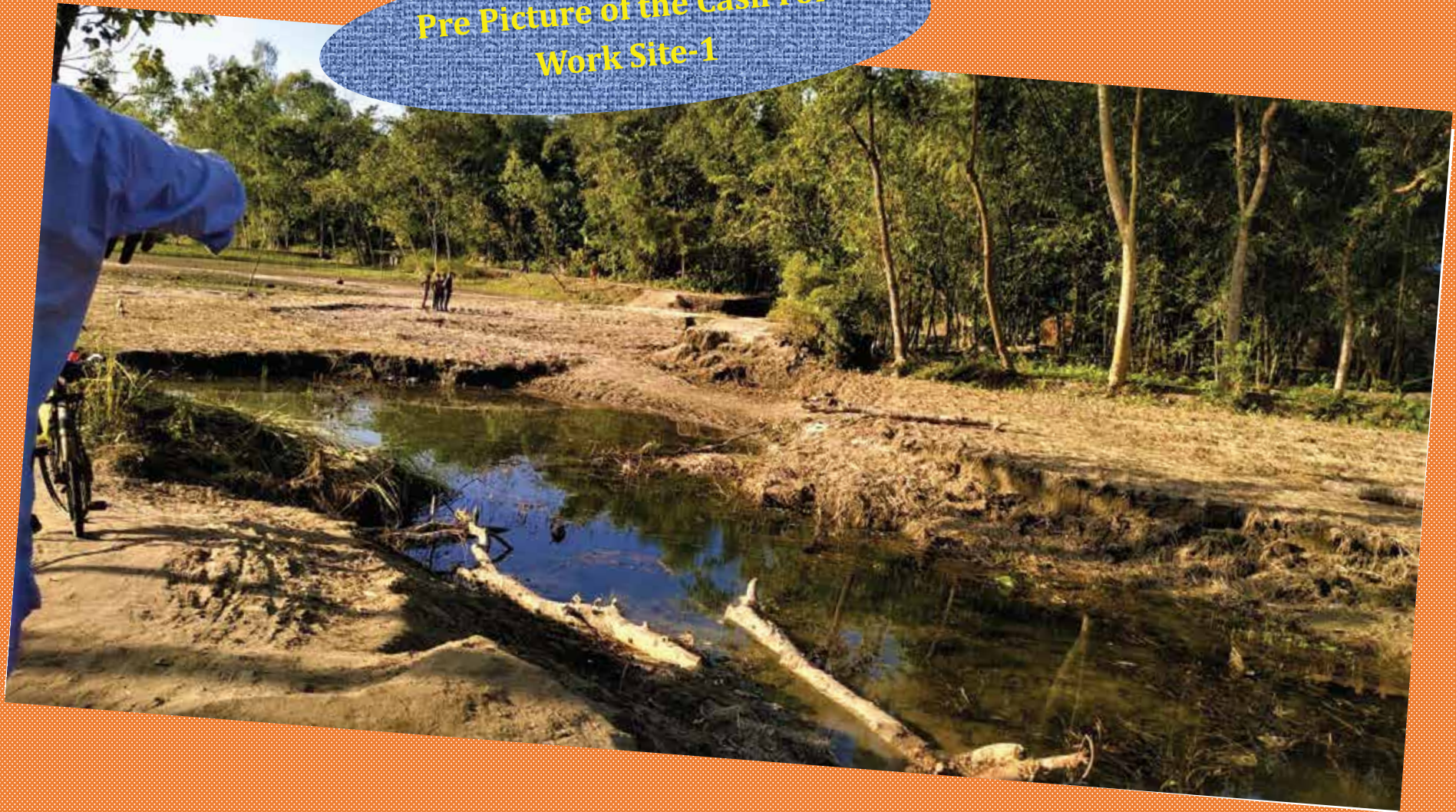
